

Steps in Establishing an Ethical Rehoming Program:



Decision-Making and Paperwork:


- Determine the feasibility of establishing a rehoming program and allocate necessary resources.
- Obtain IACUC involvement and approval.
- Find and approve the new home responsibility of the donors.
- Secure approval from the regional veterinarian.



Pre-Rehoming Preparations:

Once all administrative requirements are completed, the next step is to prepare the animals for the rehoming process. This includes:

- Veterinary checkup
- Sterilization
- Arranging safe transportation



Collaboration with the new homeowners and professional staff to ensure safe acclimation:

- Provide food and enrichment tools familiar to the animals from their previous home.
- Provide medication protocol if needed.
- Visit the animals regularly to ensure good handling and treatment.

Most importantly, create a good and open relationship between the professional staff of both homes to ensure long-term and effective support for the pigs.
